

applicant may be balloted for, and received or rejected, or the ballot may be postponed until the ensuing stated meeting, as the Lodge may determine.

The petition must give the christian and surname of the candidate, his age, profession, and place of abode—that these particulars may be correctly recorded, and mentioned in the next summons.

No. 7.

The brother proposing a candidate for initiation, shall, at the time of the proposition, deposit in the hands of the Treasurer \$10. If the candidate be not elected, the deposit shall be returned; but if the candidate be elected, and do not present himself for initiation within three months after his election (unless sufficient cause be shown for his non-attendance,) the election shall become void, and the deposit money shall be forfeited to the General Fund of the Lodge.

No. 8.

At the ballot for admitting a brother to join the Lodge, his Grand Lodge certificate must be produced, together with the certificate of his former Lodge, of all his dues being paid up. No brother for affiliation shall be eligible until he shall have visited the Lodge.
