

For every package of Canadian Petroleum or Naptha containing not more than five gallons, 2 cents.  
 For every package of imported Petroleum or Naptha containing more than ten, but not more than fifty gallons, 30 "  
 For every package of imported Petroleum or Naptha containing more than five and not more than ten gallons, 10 "  
 For every package of imported Petroleum or Naptha containing not more than five gallons, 5 "  
 For every package of Canadian or Imported Petroleum containing more than fifty gallons, 5 cts. for each additional ten gallons, or fraction of ten gallons.

### Table of Stamp Duties.

Stamps required on Notes, Drafts, or Bills of Exchange executed singly:—  
 Under \$25, Free.  
 For \$25, 1 cent.  
 For \$50 and over \$25, 2 cents.  
 For \$100 and over \$50, 3 cents.  
 For each additional \$100, 3 cents.  
 For each additional fraction of \$100, 3 cents.  
 On Drafts or Bills of Exchange in Duplicate:—  
 For \$100, 2 cents.  
 For each additional, 2 cents.  
 For each additional fraction of \$100, 2 cents.  
 On Drafts or Bills of Exchange in more parts than two:—  
 For every \$100, 1 cent.  
 For every additional \$100, 1 cent.  
 Interest made payable at the maturity of any Bill, etc., shall be counted as part of the principal sum.  
 Stamps must be cancelled at the time of affixing the same, by writing or stamping thereon the date.  
 The Stamps for Notes, &c., to be affixed by the maker or drawer; and in case of any Draft or Bill of Exchange drawn out of the Dominion, by the acceptor or first drawer or holder.
