

Bullish Sentiment Still in Ascendancy in Mining Markets

Further Progress Is Made In Movement to Higher Prices

Porcupine Issues Continue in Strong Demand at Week-End—Some Indications of Hesitancy Apparent.

World Office, Saturday Evening, Nov. 18.
The Porcupine stocks continued active and strong again at the week-end session of the local exchanges, prices being once more on the up grade, and several further advances being realized as a result of the unabated demand. The day's trading was naturally not up to that current during the earlier part of the week, but considering the fact that the session was only half the ordinary period, showed up remarkably well. Transactions were fairly well distributed throughout the list, but it was apparent that some speciality dealings were under way, and this sufficed to keep certain sections of the market pretty well in the background.

A slight feeling of hesitancy was in evidence at times, due to a profit-taking disposition which developed with the realization of the higher prices, but this was only natural in view of the fact that during the whole week the market has been distinctly buoyant and this practically without an interruption. The big issues did not do very much. Dome, Hollinger and Fire all being rather apathetic. The first two mentioned showed an easier trend, liquidation carrying prices down to a slight extent. Fire, on the other hand, was higher, crossing the \$3 mark, and holding its advance through.

In the cheaper issues interest was mainly confined to Dome Extension, Vipond, Crown Chartered and Jupiter. The trading in these stocks was active, but prices in the main did not undergo much change, sufficient selling orders being in evidence to hold any prospective movements to small limits. Dome Extension was the particularly strong point, these shares getting up over a point to \$1-7/8, and closing around the top figures. Crown Chartered gained another fraction of a point at \$4-1/4. Jupiter was more buoyant than for some days, scoring a five-point gain to \$4. Vipond was active between \$7-3/4 and \$8-1/2, and closed around the top for the day. As no time was yesterday's figures exceeded. A slump of over a point in Time-keeping, which sold off to \$2-1/2, was the only feature of the Cobalt, which were generally quiet and unchanged. The market thrust was in a strong upward and outward, with special instances there was no disposition to liquidate on holdings. Sentiment at the week-end was entirely favorable to holders, the general feeling being that, while a reaction of slight proportion was due, further progress toward a better range of values would not be long delayed.

LA ROSE RESULTS

Profits for September \$94,778—Nine Months Profit \$916,755.

COBALT, Nov. 18.—Operating profits of La Rose for the month of September, 1911, which indicates that earnings are being maintained greatly in excess of the dividend requirements, calling for approximately \$50,000 per month. During the month there were produced 32,675 ounces of silver, having a gross value of \$164,000. Total expenses amounted to \$69,921, giving the resulting net profits shown above.

For the first nine months of this year production amounted to 231,946 ounces of silver, having a gross value of \$1,144,000. Shipments during these months aggregated \$1,738,888. Total income was \$1,403,683, while total expenses amounted to \$235,885, resulting in an operating profit for the nine months of \$1,167,798, or an average of approximately \$129,000 per month.

Shaw Township Making Good.
Mr. J. E. Brayley of Spadina-ave. has just returned from Porcupine, where he has been supervising the work on his claims in the southeast part of Shaw Township. Mr. Brayley was fortunate in securing one of the best properties in that section. One of the veins, uncovered for a distance of five hundred feet, has proved to be a true fissure vein and, taken at a considerable depth, are highly satisfactory.

There is considerable work being done in this neighborhood. The formations are the same as those in North Dore and Tisdale, and there is every indication, where work has been done, since the fire, that just as rich ore bodies will be opened up as those a little further to the north.
