Securities Under Influence of Nile

Improved Outlook, and Should These Two Disquieting Features

Saturday Evening, Oct. 23.

This week's stock markets have been almost entirely dominated by the Fashoda difficulty. When on Mounday the war cloud lowered black upon the horizon, a semulanicky feeling was in evidence upon European Stock exchanges. Paris rentes declined sharply and consols fell off a point at London. British holders sold American ratis and Wall-street responded with a decline of a point or more in leading is sues. The ratiway list was particularly depressed under the additional weight of the United States Superior Court's decision against the Joint Traffic Association. Next day, Tuesday, the outlook in the Nile affort seemed less acute, whereupon securities began to recover, and ever since the financial world has exhibited a more confident and at times an almost builish tone.

An encouraging feature at present is New York's fadure to reficet the stringency in the foreign money markets, and another is the builish feeling as regards Grangers, which is based on the extraordinary crop of this season. Should the Republicans win the Congressional contest, which culminates on Nov. 4, as seems probable, and should the Anglo-French dispute be amic ably settled, of which there is evidently every likelihood, securities should attain a higher level of values. A Democratic victory across the line the coming week might break the market.
