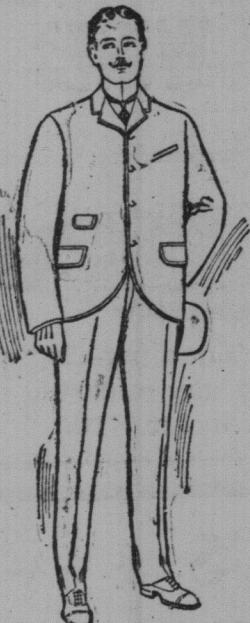

Awaiting that day the present to a policy of widening of duties on imported goods, as exemplified by the new taxes on coal, sugar, wheat and flour, and if the colonies shall prefer the question of sharing the defence of the empire the British empire will be prepared to exempt them from all taxes on imported goods, placing the colonial producer on the same footing as the British producer."
