SYDNEY OR HALIFAX

Must Be the Terminus of the Fast Atlantic Line.

London, Aug. 1.—Sir Christopher Furness organized a meeting of shipowners which was held yesterday at West Hartlepool. It was resolved to protest against the payment of subsidies by the British government for a fast Atlantic line, except for the purpose of securing an efficient mail service.

In the opinion of Canadian shippers and Canadian business men in London, generally, no freight subsidy should be given to the Canadian Pacific Railway. Many are also opposed to the enormous passenger subsidy. The British-Canadian Line, however, declares that even the best Canadian line will not divert a pound of freight or a single passenger from the existing routes. It is also the prevailing opinion that the terminal port of the fast Canadian line must be Sydney or Halifax. No greyhound could maintain speed on the St. Lawrence River to Quebec.

PLAN TO AID THE HARVESTERS

Winnipeg Made the Central Point for Distributing Them Free to the Wheat Fields.

EXCURSIONS START ON THE 19TH

Scenes of Prosperity in the Prairie Province as Witnessed by a Government Official.

The government of Manitoba are now calculating the number of men required for the harvest, using as a basis of their calculation the certificates sent in from the farmers throughout the province and in the Northwest Territories, stating the number of men that they expect to have work for. It is expected that the number arrived at in this way will be made known in the course of a few days. In addition to these cards sent to the different crop correspondents, similar cards were also sent to every railway agent in the province. The cards are made out for the name of the farmer to be attached, the number of men required for cutting, number for stacking, total number, and time for first party to arrive.

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George A. Halse of Brandon, one of the best known farmers of Manitoba, has arrived in Toronto on his return from a trip to England, and in speaking to The World expressed his decided approval of the plan adopted by the government of Manitoba with a view to securing proper distribution of the men after their arrival. He had no doubt that the labor problem would develop into a serious one in the prairie province. The transporting of large numbers of men to any one district for a few months in the year was bound to result in more or less trouble, which would be avoided to a great extent if the men going out had intentions of staying there. The best men were those intending to be permanent settlers, and he had no doubt that many of the young men who were so anxious to get back after the harvest could get steady employment the year round if they were desirous of making a new home for themselves. Mr. Halse would want harvesters not to go to the wheat fields with any preconceived idea of securing enormous wages. It was unreasonable for them to expect \$50 and \$60 and board a month as many did last year. It just amounts to this, that the farmers could not

MORE CHILDREN IN QUEBEC

Ontario Shows a Decrease in Population of Infants.

Ottawa, Aug. 1.—The census department has issued the following report which shows that there are less than more children under five years in Quebec than in Ontario, altho the latter is one-third larger in population than Quebec.

Since 1871 there has been a remarkable decrease in the population of infants in Ontario and Prince Edward Island.

The provinces showing the largest proportion over 70 years are Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Ontario. The largest of every 10 years in Canada are people over 70 years of age and 23 are children up to 9 years. The largest proportion of children under 10 is in the Northwest, with Quebec and Manitoba closely following.
