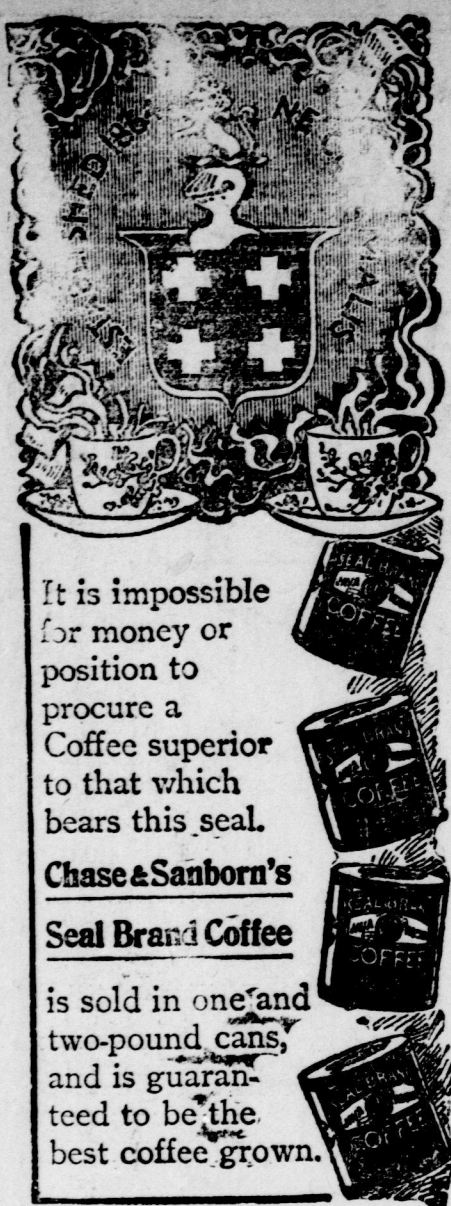

Suicide of a Canadian Woman in Cleveland—Fatal Accidents at Ingersoll, Harrietsville and Other Points.
