that admission confers no right of permanent residence in the "Home," and at any time the Managers have the power of dismissing an inmate, for what they may deem a sufficient cause. Of its sufficiency, the Managers are to be the sole judges.

Any person received into this "Home," as a free patient, if possessed of money or property shall be required to convey the same to the Board for the use of the Institution ; and if inheriting property while an inmate of the "Home," and desiring to leave, shall be required to pay the usual charge for board, during the period of residence in the "Home."

X. Any members absenting themselves from three consecutive monthly meetings, except in cases of illness or absence from the city, shall have their names struck off the list of the Managing Committee.
