Thomas M'Kay, Mr. George Malloch, Elders ;-and from the Presbytery of Kingston, Dr. John Machar, Mr. Robert Neill, Professor Smith, Professor George, Ministers; Mr. Andrew Drummond, and Mr. David Allan, Elders: To BE COMMISSIONERS of this Synod, to the effect after mentioned; with power to the said Commissioners, or their quorum, which is hereby declared to be any Five of the said Commissioners, whereof Three are always to be Ministers, to meet in St. Andrew's Church, at Kingston, on Wednesday, the 4th day of October, at 12 o'clock noon; and in St. Andrew's Church, at Montreal, on Wednesday, the 7th day of February, at 12 o'clock, noon, being the day appointed for the meeting of the Montreal Presbytery; and oftener, when and where they shall think fit and convenient. And the Synod fully empower their said Commissioners, or their quorum above-mentioned, to transact all business referred to them by the Synod, and to determine in the same as they shall see cause, -also to attend to such emergent cases as may require immediate action on the part of the Church,-and to watch over the general interests of the Church, that the Church do not suffer or sustain any prejudice which they can prevent: Further, the said Commission is hereby empowered to receive any References and Appeals that shall be made to them from Presbyteries, and ripen such affairs for next Synod,—and to give all needful advice to Presbyteries, upon application to them for that end: And in all their actings they shall proceed according to the Laws of the Church, and they shall be accountable for the same to next meeting of Synod. And this Commission is to continue until the next meeting of Synod; and members are required to attend the Diets of the said Commission: And such members of the Presbytery within whose bounds the Commission meets, as are on the Commission, are required all of them, to attend, -and other Presbyte-
