At the close of the year our roll shewed 39 active and 9 associate members.

The fact that the great C. E. Convention was held in our city, gave the Society an impetus felt by all in an increased attendance, earnestness, and willingness to do something for the Master.

The Charitable Committee have attended to the clothing of a pupil in the Mackay Institute as well as furnishing clothes and provisions to others.

The Missionary Committee have carried on regular weekly collections for both Home and Foreign Missions, and have also distributed self-denial boxes among the members in aid of mission work in the North-West. Amounting in all for missions to \$62.56.
