Rogers was promoted to corporal May 1, 1952; sergeant Nov. 1, 1960.

ROMENCO Reg. No. 14548, ex-S/Sgt. Alexander Romenco, 77, died May 31, 1998, at Waterloo, Ont. He was born March 15, 1921, at Fish Creek, Sask., and joined the Force Jan. 11, 1943, at Edmonton, Alta. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Romenco was posted to "C" Division, at Montréal, and was transferred to the following locations: Dec. 30, 1946, to "E" Division, B.C., at Vancouver; Sept. 1, 1947, to "F" Division, Sask., at Swift Current, Morse and Kipling; May 1, 1949, to "A" Division, at Ottawa; Nov. 16, 1949, to "Depot" Division; Nov. 1, 1951, to "F" Division, at Saskatoon; June 1, 1954, to RCMP HQ, retiring Apr. 10, 1967. Romenco was promoted to corporal May 1, 1955; sergeant May 1, 1958; staff sergeant May 1, 1963.

SCOTT P/S 8950, PSE Colleen Lynne Scott, 47, died May 15, 1998, at Ottawa. She was born May 20, 1950, at Winnipeg, Man., and joined the Force as a public service employee May 7, 1973, at Ottawa. She was posted to RCMP HQ where she was still working at the time of her death.

SCOTT Reg. No. C/1057, ex-C/M Ivan James Scott, 74, died June 9, 1998, at Fruitvale, B.C. He was born Sept. 22, 1923, at Port Arthur, Ont., and joined the Force as a civilian member Jan. 12, 1972, at Vancouver. Scott was posted to "E" Division, at Vancouver, retiring Sept. 22, 1988. He had served in the Royal Canadian Air Force (1941/46 —1953/72). For his wartime service, Scott had been awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, the 1939-45 Star, the Aircrew Europe Star, the Defence Medal, the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and Clasp, the War Medal 1939-45, and the Canadian Forces Decoration and Clasp.

SEDGWICK Reg. No. C/283, ex-C/M Wilbert Ernest Sedgwick, 68, died Apr. 8, 1998, at Regina. He was born June 22, 1929, at Neudorf, Sask., and joined the Force as a civilian member Nov. 18, 1963, at Regina. Sedgwick was posted to "F" Division, Sask., at Yorkton, and was subsequently transferred to the following locations: July 1, 1970, to "K" Division, Alta., at Edmonton; Sept. 25, 1978, to RCMP HQ; Jan. 21, 1985, to "K" Division, at Edmonton, retiring Nov. 17, 1989.

SIMS Reg. No. 18795, ex-Cst. Bertrand Peter Sims, 70, died June 1, 1998, at Princeton, B.C. He was born

May 20, 1928, at Oxford, England, and joined the Force Nov. 2, 1954, at Vancouver, B.C. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Sims was posted there, and was transferred to the following locations: Nov. 1, 1955, to "K" Division, Alta., at Red Deer and Wetaskiwin; Oct. 1, 1957, to "G" Division, at Alexandra Fiord (N.W.T.) and Whitehorse (Yukon); June 6, 1961, to "E" Division, at North Vancouver, taking his discharge Jan. 31, 1963. Sims served in the Royal Air Force (May 1946-Oct. 1948).

STEWART Reg. No. 17511, ex-S/Sgt. Gerald Alexander Stewart, 66, died Apr. 11, 1998, at Victoria, B.C. He was born July 4, 1931, at Winnipeg, Man., where he joined the Force Jan. 28, 1952. Upon completion of training at "N" and "Depot" Divisions, Stewart was posted to "E" Division, B.C., at Prince George, took his discharge Dec. 10, 1953, and reengaged into the Force Sept. 13, 1955, at Winnipeg. He was posted to "K" Division, Alta., at Edmonton, and was transferred to the following locations: Apr. 1, 1957, to "E" Division, B.C., at Victoria; May 1, 1959, to RCMP HQ; June 21, 1963, to "D" Division, Man., at Winnipeg; Aug. 1, 1967, to "K" Division, at Calgary; Sept. 1, 1970, to "D" Division at Winnipeg, retiring Apr. 12, 1982. Stewart was promoted to corporal May 1, 1962; sergeant May 1, 1967; staff sergeant Feb. 1, 1971.

STREETER Reg. No. 33661, Cpl. Eric Russel Streeter, 46, died May 20, 1998, at Regina. He was born May 12, 1952, at Gourrock, Scotland, and joined the Force Oct. 12, 1976, at Montréal. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Streeter was posted to "K" Division, Alta., at Red Deer and was transferred to the following locations: July 1, 1983, to "G" Division, N.W.T., at Frobisher Bay, Inuvik and Igloolik; Apr. 17, 1991, to RCMP HQ; Apr. 1, 1993, to "A" Division, at Ottawa; Aug. 12, 1997, to "Depot" where he was still working at the time of his death. STUART Reg. No. 19726, ex-Cst. Bruce Charles Stuart, 60, died in May, 1998. He was born Aug. 8, 1937, at Beebe, Que., and joined the Force Jan. 3, 1957, at Montréal. Upon completion of training at "N" and "Depot" Divisions, Stuart was posted to "J" Division, N.B., at Saint John and Fredericton, taking his discharge Aug. 15, 1959.

STUBBS Reg. No. 12764, ex-Cpl. Frederick Stubbs, 85, died Apr. 9, 1998, at Ottawa. He was born June 22, 1912, at Sheffield, England, and joined the Force July 13, 1935, at Ottawa. Upon completion of training at "N" Division, Stubbs was posted to "D" Division, Man., at Winnipeg. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: Apr. 1, 1937,
