on the past of any husband, not to bar the right of his widow to dower out of his lands, or any of them.

No dower out of equitable estates.

IX. So much of the Act of the Legislature of Upper Canada, passed in the fourth year of the reign of King William the Fourth, initialed "An Act to amend the Law respecting real property, and to render the proceedings for recovering possession thereof in certain cases, less difficult and expensive," as gives dower out of equitable estates or estates partly legal and partly equitable, is hereby repealed.

Extent of Act. X. This Act shall apply only to dower on lands in Upper Canada, and shall extend to all cases where the husband shall die after its 10 passing.
