## BILL.

## An Act to divide the Township of Whitby in the County of Ontario, into two separate Municipalities.

WHEREAS the public convenience of the inhabitants of the Township Preamble. of Whitby would be promoted by a division of that Township into two separate Municipalities: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as fol-

I. Upon and after the first day of January next after the passing of this Township of Act, that part or portion of the present Township of Whitby, from Lots East Whitby one to seventeen inclusive, from the shore of Lake Ontario to the rear of formed. the Township, shall be set apart, and shall form a separate Municipality, to be called the Township of East Whitby.

II. For the purposes of the Municipal election to be held in the said Returning Officer at first Township of East Whitby next after the passing of this Act, the County election. Council of the County of Ontario shall at its first session immediately after the passing of this Act, appoint a returning officer, and the said election Place of holdshall be held at the Village of Columbus.

III. The provisions of the Upper Canada Municipal Corporations Act of Act of 1849, 1849, as respects the separation of Townships shall apply to the Township c. 81, to apply of Whitby and East Whitby; Provided always, that the share of the Clergy As to share of Reserve Fund already distributed or to be distributed, and which shall at the Clergy Repassing of this Act remain in the hands of the Municipality of the Town-20 ship of Whitby, invested or otherwise, and unappropriated to any special Township purpose, shall belong to and be equally divided between the Township of Whitby and East Whitby.

IV. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
