## BILL。

An $A$ et to extend the provisions of the Truo hundrad and seventyfifth Section of the Act "respecting the Muinicicinat Institutions of $U_{p p e}$. Canada" and to provide for the Election of Souncillors in the several townshijis of Upper Canada, whenever the same may be divided into Rlectoial Divisioas unuer the authority of the said Section.

HER MA.JESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. Whenever a township in Upper Canada is divided into Electoral Heeting of Divisions, and Polling places established thercin, and Returning Officers Diectors at 5 appointed therefor, under and by the provisions of the Two hundred and Hannerip no-Seventy-fifth Section of Chapter Fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes mination of for Upper Canada, a meeting of the Electorsfor such tomnship shall take candidates. place for the nomination of candidates, for the Councillors to be clected for the eaid township, at the Township Hall if there be one in the said township, but if there be no Township Hall, then at the place where the first meeting of the Council of the said township was held for the then current year, on the last Monday but one in the month of December, before the Annual Election as provided by the said Act, at ten of the - clock in the forenoon. person to preside in his place; and if the Clerk or the person so apside atsuch pointed does not attend, the electors present shall choose a chairman, being an elector, to officiate from among themselves.
2. Such clerk or person so appointed or chairman so chosen, shall Powrers of haveall the powers of a Returning Officer. such chairman.
3. If only five candidates have been within one hour proposed by any Ifonly. five of the electors present at such meeting, the clerk or person so appointed candidites. to preside, or chairman so chosen as the case may be, shall declare such candidates duly elected Councillors to serve for the then next following year.
4. If more than five candidates shall be proposed at such meeting, If more than and any candidate proposed after the first five, or any elector on his five candibehalf, shall demand a Poll, the said clerk or person so appointed or chairman so chosen shall, on the following day, post up in the office of the clerk the names of the candidates so proposed, and give notice of the names to the Returning Officer appointed for each and all the said Electoral Divisions.

In case of the nomination of more than five candidates, and no If mose than candidate nominated after the first five, or no elector on his or their five cardibehalf then demanding a Poll as aforesaid, the Clerk or person so dates bat no appointed, or Chairman so chosen, shall declare such five candidates $\frac{\text { poll }}{}$ first nominated daly elected Councillors to serve as aforesaic?
