

# CANADIAN BOY SCOUTS

Thousands of boys in all the chief centres of Canada are now regularly enrolled as members of the unique arm of the military force, inaugurated by Gen. Baden-Powell in England. This is the most significant military movement in the Empire of the twentieth century. In Toronto alone there are two thousand of these young practical soldiers; in Montreal, thousands more; so also in the cities of the East and the West.
