

# Course 107 Champions In Fastball

OVER 300 airmen took part in the various athletic events staged at Varsity Stadium on Wednesday afternoon in connection with the commemoration of the third anniversary of the opening of No. 4 Initial Training School.

The 16-team fastball tournament, feature event of the day, was won by Course 107, who defeated Course 104 in the final by a score of 4-3, the winning run coming in the last inning.

There were 34 teams in horseshoe pitching, 24 competitors in base-running, 20 in the fastball throw and 12 in fungo hitting.

A triple tie resulted in the greased pig event, LAC. D. M. Harding of Winnipeg, AC2 G. I. DePape of Swan Lake, Man., and LAC. Munson of Fort Saskatchewan, all finishing in a "dead heat" in the opinion of the judges.

AC2 Black and AC2 Archibald of Course 107, tied with LAC. Jenkins and LAC. Ashton of Course 103 in the commando event. Both pairs covered the quarter-mile obstacle or commando course in 1 minute, 30 seconds.

Flt. Sgt. Sellers was the eventual winner of the base-running, when he defeated Flying Officer McPherson and AC2 Cholak in a run-off, the three having finished in a tie.

The fastball throw was won by AC2 McDonald, Course 104, with AC2 Reich, Course 104 placing second.

First prize in fungo hitting went to Sgt. Lush, Headquarters, with AC2 Budsey, W.E.T.P. taking second.

The horseshoe pitching competition was won by Sgt. Bray and Sgt. Calhoun of Headquarters, who defeated LAC. Halliday and LAC. Dzudan of Course 104 in the final.

The officers' fastball squad was eliminated in the first round of the 16-team tournament, bowing out after and extra inning was played.
