Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 25th instant, in regard to resolution of Council of the Chippewas of the Thames, in favour of granting permission to Frederick Fox, a member of the Band, to sell a quantity of gravel - one acre - to the county Council for the purpose of gravelling the town line road, I beg to say that, in view of representations made, that the use of this gravel will be of great benefit to the Indians, the Department is inclined to sanction the arrangement made, on the understanding that in addition to what is paid Fox for the right to take the gravel, there shall also be paid to you for transmission to the Department, to be placed to the credit of Band funds, the sum of ten cents per load for all the gravel taken out, the quantity of which should be reported under sworn returns.
