met Curran's imprivements reported that the only claims he found on the Reserve in question were near the South East corner - one contain. ing 10 acres ploughed, no fewerthe other containing about 5 acres fenced and under exop; strat shere was an old dilapidated build. ing which had be thought been used as a hill by the Mission, but must have been abandoned long ago and that it was of no value. mes Simpson subsequently stated in a letter to the assistant Indian Commissioner for the horth West Zeontinies that he could not place any value on she old building which had been a niell, that when he made the servey it was in a very dilapidated condition
