Memorandum -

Indian Agents, Manitoba, Saskatchevan and Alberta.

You will please note that when treaty is being paid on the reserves in the above mentioned provinces, traders, other than those established on the reserves by permit of the Department, are not to be allowed to take up even temporary residence on the reserves with the object of trading with the Indians at the time of payment nor for thirty days thereafter.

All Agents will, therefore, be good enough to take such steps as are necessary to see that the wishes of the Department in this matter are fully respected.
