Selkirk, Man., March 21st. 1936. Dear Sir:-On January 25th. we require the Department for a new brief case and a satchel in which to carry the money and stationery during our treaty trip. You were kind enough to request us to again bring the matter to the attention of the Department about the last week in March, when the same would be given consideration.
