In reply to your letter of the 12th Instant, in regard to Mr.Blake's claim for damages to the amount of \$15.00, for loss sustained to his stock by the neglect of the Locatee to build the fence agreed upon in his lease of Location 28, Alnwick, I have to inform you that in view of the circumstances, the Department will allow Mr.Blake the sum of \$15.00 from rents payable on 1st Instant, provided he forwards the full amount of rent to the Department, when you may requisition for the said sum in the name of Mr.Blake.

You should also obtain from Mr.Blake when he receives the said sum, a receipt in full for all damages he has sustained.
