In reply I beg to say that your returns for the year ended June 30, last, show that your school was kept open as follows:-

structions to teachers, you will see that your school must be kept open at least 216 days in the year and that the aggregate number of holidays, including Saturdays and and statutory holidays
Sundays, must not, therefore, exceed 149 days. You taught only 194 days out of the 216 28 shown by the above statement, but as you were ill for four days in the December. quarter you were allowed for that time and also for five days as days of obligation, which would bring the number of days for which you were allowed up to 303, leaving
