

Ottawa, May 26, 1911.

Dear Mr. Macbeth,-

Referring to your letter to Hon.

Mr. Oliver, of the 17th instant, I beg to state that our plan of the surrendered portion of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve apparently agrees with the plan of the right of way, filed in this department, by the Southern Alberta Land Company, of its irrigation ditch.

The heading, "Top. No. R. No. V. 4 N." has been omitted in the pamphlet. This is a ~~capital~~ or ~~principally~~ error, but all the valuations of the land in the township are given in the pamphlet.

An error has occurred in Parcel No. 402, consisting in a small portion, containing eight acres, in the north half of the section, having been omitted. The area should read as follows:-

402 - - - - All south of ditch 225 acres 600.00
