

Ottawa, May 20, 1911.

Dear Mr. McGrath,

Referring to your letter to Hon. Mr. Oliver, of the 17th instants, I beg to state that our plans of the surrendered portion of the Blackfoot Indian reserve apparently accord with the plan of the right of way, filed in this department, by the Southern Alberta Land Company, of its irrigation ditch.

The heading, "T. 20, R. 20, W. 4 M." has been omitted in the pamphlet. This is a clerical or printer's error, but all the valuations of the land in the township are given in the pamphlet.

An error has occurred in Parcel No. 402, consisting in a small portion, containing eight acres, in the north half of the section, having been omitted. The item should read as follows:

402 - - - - - " All south of ditch 805 acres \$20.00
