With reference to the purchase of certain lands on  
Bittern Island I have to request you to inform the Indian  
Council that the Department of Justice has explained that the  
delay has been caused by the fact that none of the proprietors  
are domiciled in the United States and a testamentary trust  
has been executed in favor of one of them who cannot sell his  
share before the 25th June, 1914; steps are however being taken  
to overcome this difficulty and it is expected that the deeds  
will soon be forwarded to this Department.
