I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant in which you inform the Department that the Principal of the Cecilia Jeffrey Boarding School has several applications for admission to his school, but that, owing to the cost of bringing a doctor to have them examined, their certificates of health forms have not been signed.

In reply I beg to say that the nurse and Principal of this school may examine these applicants and sign the certificates of health and, if the applications are otherwise satisfactory, their admission will be approved. These children should, however, be examined by a physician on the occasion of his first visit to this school.
