Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, I regret to say that the Department cannot allow you a bonus as requested for your services in looking after the work of construction on the bridge and culvert therein mentioned. I may add that the provisions of the Civil Service Act preclude a payment such as you request being made to you, as the salary which you receive covers all work which you are called upon to perform on behalf of the Indians.
