Whereas a Petition has been presented to me signed by the following Brothers viz
William Campbell, Thomas Ridout, John Henry Dunn, George Murray, Nathan Coffin, John Gates, Thomas Fitzgerald,
John Scott, James Agg, John Baines Surgeon and Daniel Brooks. Praying for a Warrant of Constitution or such other
Authority as may be convenient to me to grant, empowering them to form a regular Lodge of Antient Free and Accepted
Masons at York in the Home District of Upper Canada. Now Know Ye, That having taken the same into
several Consideration do hereby authorise and empower our said Brothers to hold a Lodge and to enter, pass and make All Masonic
Conformably to the Laws and Constitutions of the Grand Lodge, and not otherwise, and to do all such other acts as may lawfully be
done by a regular incorporated Lodge.

And I do hereby approve the election of officers made by the said
Petitioners and hereby appoint the said Brother William Campbell Worshipful Master, Brother Thomas Ridout Senior
Warden and Brother John Henry Dunn Junior Warden, and direct that they and their successors duly elected and appointed shall continue
in the said offices until such time as a Warrant shall be granted to them for a Lodge under the seal of the Grand Lodge of England.

And for so doing the Dispensation shall be given sufficiently authority to remain in force until such Warrant shall have been granted
but subject always to the approval of the Most Worshipful Grand Master And the said Lodge shall be called Number one, and
addition to the said number to affix the name of St Andrews Lodge

I have under my hand and seal at York in the said Province the Twenty fourth day
of September in the year of our Lord 1822 and of Malony 3722.
