

GENUS RALLUS.

76. King Rail.

(Rallus elegans.)

A regular summer resident of the marshes at the western end of Lake Erie.

I have not heard of its occurrence elsewhere.

77. Virginia Rail.

(Rallus virginianus.)

An abundant summer resident of the marshes of southern Ontario, breeding throughout its range in the Province.

Arrives about the middle of April and leaves early in October.

GENUS PORZANA.

SUBGENUS PORZANA.

78. Carolina Rail.

(Porzana carolina.)

Very abundant summer resident of the marshes all over the Province, breeding throughout its range.

Arrives about the middle of April, departs about the end of October.

SUBGENUS COTURNICOPS.

79. Yellow Rail.

(Porzana noveboracensis.)

A regular but not a common summer resident of our marshes.

SUBGENUS CRECISCUS.

*80. Black Rail.

(Porzana jamaicensis.)

Very rare, probably a summer resident where it occurs.

SUBFAMILY GALLINULINÆ. GALLINULES.

GENUS IONORNIS.

81. Purple Gallinule.

(Ionornis martinica.)

Of accidental occurrence here, one was taken in the marsh on the Rouge river east of Toronto in 1892, but I know of no others.
