

and his Surname at length, the same to be kept hanging in the most convenient place in his house, never to be removed or used, except on alarm of fire, on penalty of *Ten Shillings*.

III. That upon alarm of fire, every Member shall repair with his Bags and Buckets to such of the members of this Society, as shall be most in danger, and endeavour to the utmost of his power to save their effects and secure them by carefully conveying them to some convenient place, to the best of his judgment, and to prevent the embezzlement of them, and whoever shall wilfully neglect his attendance shall pay a fine of *Twenty Shillings*, to the Clerk for the use of the Society.

IV. That a President be chosen annually on the THIRD Tuesday in *February* for the orderly transacting the business of this Society at their several meetings who shall attend to all motions made and seconded, and put the same to vote, every
