and substitute provided, from two consecutive business meetings shall be equivalent to resignation.

CLAUSE F—Officers and conveners of standing committees shall be elected at the annual

meeting.

CLAUSE G—A nominating committee of seven members in good standing shall be appointed by the League two meetings before the annual meeting, and shall submit its report at the business meeting next before the annual meeting. Any other nominations may be handed in, and these must be endorsed by at least THREE voting members.

## ARTICLE IV

DUTIES OF OFFICERS

CLAUSE A—The President shall preside at all meetings; shall enforce a strict observance of the rules of the League; shall appoint all special committees; shall be a member exofficio of all committees; shall call special meetings and meetings of the Executive Committee.

CLAUSE B—In case of the inability of the President to act, the First Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President, and failing the first

the Second Vice esident shall act.

CLAUSE C—The Recording Secretary shall keep minutes of each meeting, shall prepare matters for publication, shall have charge of all books and papers of the League, shall notify all members of meetings, and shall report without delay to the Corresponding Secretary whatever business requires to be dealt with by that officer.

CLAUSE D—The Corresponding Secretary shall conduct all correspondence of the League; shall notify officers and conveners of their election; shall keep a list of names, standing and address of members; shall receive membership fees, and send out to each new member a membership card and a copy of the constitution; shall send in to the Recording Secretary names and addresses of all mem-
