to that end to establish and conduct or contribute towards Colleges, Libraries, Classes, Lectures and Examinations, and prescribe such tests of competency, fitness and moral character as may be thought expedient. Every member of the Institute shall have the right to use the designation "Chartered Accountant" or the initials "C. A." and may use after his name, if the Institute shall have granted to him a Certificate of Fellowship, the initials "F. C. A." signifying "Fellow of the Chartered Accountant", and if the Institute shall have granted him a Certificate of Membership the initials "A. C. A." signifying "Associate of the Chartered Accountants."

7. The first examination shall be held before a Examinations. Board of three examiners, who shall be Chartered Accountants, appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council, and one of whom shall be one of the Incorporators named in section 1 hereof. All subsequent examinations shall be governed by the by-laws of the Institute.

8. The Institute may take, purchase and hold any Institute personal property, lands, buildings or hereditaments May Hold necessary for the purposes of the Association, and may Certain dispose thereof and re-invest the proceeds in such manner as they may deem fit, but so that the Institute shall apply all its profits, if any, and other income in promoting its objects, and shall not at any time pay any dividend to its members.

The provisions of this section shall not prevent the remuneration of members of the Council or Officers of the Institute for services rendered.

9. The Institute shall have power to affiliate with Affiliation any other Institute or Association of Accountants, with other whether in the Dominion of Canada, Great Britain, the Institutes. United States of America, or elsewhere, for purposes of mutual benefit to the profession.

10. The Institute shall have power by by-law to fix Entrance entrance fees and annual fees or subscriptions to be Fees and paid by members, and may vary the amount from time to time, and no member shall be personally liable for any debt of the Institute beyond the amount of his unpaid fees or subscription as aforesaid.

11. If any member ceases from any cause whatever Ex-members to be a member of the Institute, he shall not, nor shall have no his representatives have any interest in or claim against Claim on Institute the funds and property of the Institute. Property.
