Alfalfa on Wheat

Would it be advisable to sow Alfalfa on fall wheat? Would spring or fall sowing be the best? How much seed should be sown an acre; where could it be obtained and at what cost? Should cattle be allowed to graze on it the first fall after the wheat is out? Would it be a good thing to sow it in an orchard for pasture?—A Greenock Subseriber.

It is not advisable to sow alfalfa on fall wheat, although in rare cases good catches have been obtained in this way. If sown on wheat it should be sown late in the spring and harroard in
