



Her record for the three days of the test was 206.6 lbs. of milk and 7.85 lbs. of butter fat. Cherry's mother was a good average milker of nondescript breeding; but her sire was pure bred and it is from this sire that Cherry gets her ability as a big producer. Could we have better testimony to the value of a pure bred sire? Mr. Geo. B. Ryan, Courtland, Ont., here seen holding his cow, sold her and the 1st prize 3-year-old grade cow for \$320.
