Persons tendering are notified that tenders will not be considered unless made on the printed forms supplied, and signed with their actual signatures.

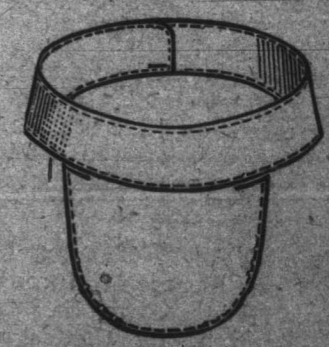
