WHEREAS an Act was passed by the Legislature of this Province in the fortieth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to provide Returning Officers, " for Knights, Citizens and Burgesses to serve in Assembly and regulating Elections to be " held for that purpose," the which Act will expire at the end of the present Session of the Provincial Parliament, and whereas it is necessary that the said Act should be continued and amended. Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed inthe Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Ac passed in the " fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act Jor making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America," " and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province." and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the said Act, " inti-" tuled " An Act to provide Returning Officers for Knights, Citizens and Burgeffes to serve in Assembly, and regulating Elections to be held for that purpose," and all matters and things therein contained, shall continue in as much as the same are not changed, altered or varied by this Act, and be in force until the first day of January One thousand eight hundred and seven, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer.
