A summary of the Canker Worn life-history is as follows: The winter is passed in the egg stage, the eggs being depos-ited in eery irregular patches or clusters on the limbs of the tree. About four or five days be-fore the appleblossoms open in the spring the young caterpil-lars emerge on the lease, often defoiliating entire orchards and getting more difficult as they grow. In the caterpillar stage they, are popularly known as measure worms or inch worms, and may be solid green or strip-ed with black, depending on their maturity. About the end of June they drop to the ground and burrow down about one inch and there pupate. About the first of November the adults appear; the males wings small winged moths which may be seen flying about the trunks of the apple trees, the females on the branches. Home-made tangle foot may be made by boiling 9 lbs of resin of T pints castor oil and 1-4 lb of corradin or beeswax together.


