## THE BOOMERANG.

Skill More Than Strength in Its Use.

Boomerangs are undoubtedly one of the most curious and interesting and most remarkable weapons in the world, considering their crudeness. The tales that have been told about the feats that can be performed with them by an expert are not myths by any means.

An Englishman has been investigating the subject in Australia, and who has reported his results, and made exhibition throws for King George says that by selecting a boomerang of suitable shape and by knowing the knack of giving it just the right twist, the natives of Queensland and New South Wales can make them do things so startling that they seem bewitched.

The boomerangs are usually made from a limb or root of a tree that has the proper crook, or sometimes they are made by heating a green stick in the fire and then bending it. They are worked out to the desired shape by scraping with flint instruments and smoothing with big stones. They are usually made round on one side and flat on the other. One form of boomerang used in war has a hook at one end.

When this instrument is thrown at an enemy he puts up his own boomerang to ward off the attack. In this action, says the Pathfinder, causes the hook to catch on his own boomerang and brings the boomerang back to the thrower. It is that it deals him a hard blow on the side of the head almost in spite of any effort he can do to parry it.

Making the boomerang perform a figure eight in the air is comparatively a common feat and all sorts of complicated figures are produced, including double loops. The test of a sure thrower is to make the stick come back obediently to his feet after making in his flight, a loop as high as the thrower's head.

One very useful throw which is often used by the natives in hunting with fox and other small animals consists in sending the boomerang in a curve which cuts across the view and then turning it around in a direction away from the game so that it then turns in its flight and goes straight through the animal's back, forming a number of scyathons, and is sure to cause considerable damage.

Amateurs have often tried to learn the trick of throwing a boomerang, but it takes long practice, much with it. There are a number of boomerangs from Australia and the Pacific Islands in the Government collection at Washington.
