Novelty in Handkerchiefs.

Colored handkerchiefs are enjoying vogue, and the most popular shades kerchief is colored, with the merest line of white at the edge in the shape of a rolled hem. In other instances this is reversed, the handkerchief being white bound with a color. Then, again, widely striped borders are used; in some cases a single stripe in 2% inches wide, leaving quite a small square of white in the centre, the rol-

led hem being also white. Very dainty are the little handkerchiefs with a veining edge in a pale color and a tiny initial or monogram to match.
