

### St. George's Day Parade

SOCIETIES ATTEND SERVICE AT COCHRANE ST. CHURCH.

The annual St. George's Day Joint Parade held yesterday was most successful. At 10 a.m. five Societies, viz., Newfoundland British Society, Loyal Orange Association, Society of United Farmers, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Sons of England Benevolent Society assembled at Cathedral Square and in the order named paraded were headed by the Silk Union Band of the British Society, next to which was the Guards brass band, a pipe band, and a marching band. The parade was begun. In the line were the Boy Scouts, Salvation Army Band and Highland Pipes. The parade wended its way down Theatre Street, New Gower Street, to Hutcheson Street, down Water Street up to Cochrane Street, where it was held at 11 a.m. after the large gathering was made, the service was commenced by the Rev. G. H. Johnson, M.A., B.D., Pastor of Cochrane Street Methodist Church, assisted by Rev. Hammond Johnson, and Rev. T. B. Darby, M.A., D.D., the spiritual part of the service was under the leadership of this organizer, Mr. Arthur Mews, and was all that could be desired.

The sermon was preached by the Rev. G. H. Johnson, the text of which was taken from the 22nd Chapter of St. Matthew, 27th, 28th, and 29th verses. Mr. Johnson dwelt on the death of St. George, 702 years ago, and gave some advice as to city, country, as well as to our duties. He also gave some very interesting data as to what England was 700 years ago and what she was today. In fact the discourse was such as to add to the excellent reputation of the Rev. gentleman, has carved himself during his stay in St. John's. The Benediction having been pronounced by the Pastor the service was brought to a close.

Following the parade, the parade committee held a luncheon at the Government House where a call was made on his Excellency the Governor, Mr. A. G. Mans (Chairman of the Joint Committee) tendering greetings to his Excellency and Lady Alford on behalf of the Societies, requested that his Excellency and Lady Alford be present at the Empire to be conveyed to his residence. Three hearty cheers were given for the King and Prince, and the Royal Family, and his Excellency and Lady Alford.

Following the gathering his Excellency thanked Mr. Williams for his words of loyalty to the King and his good wishes for himself and his family. He would also be pleased to forward the message to him by Mr. Williams through proper channel. He assured all of them that he was very glad to have them with him on this day.

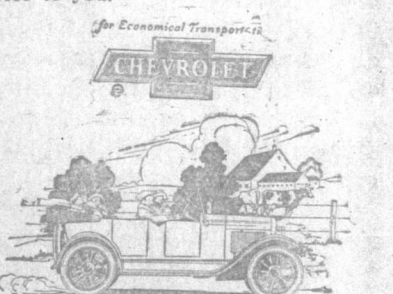
