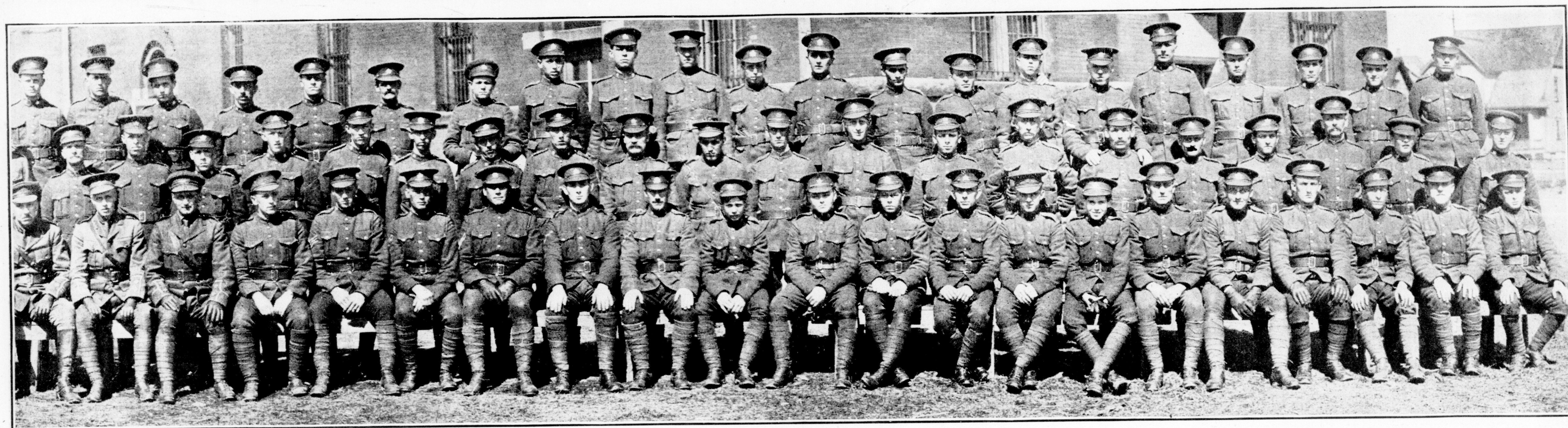
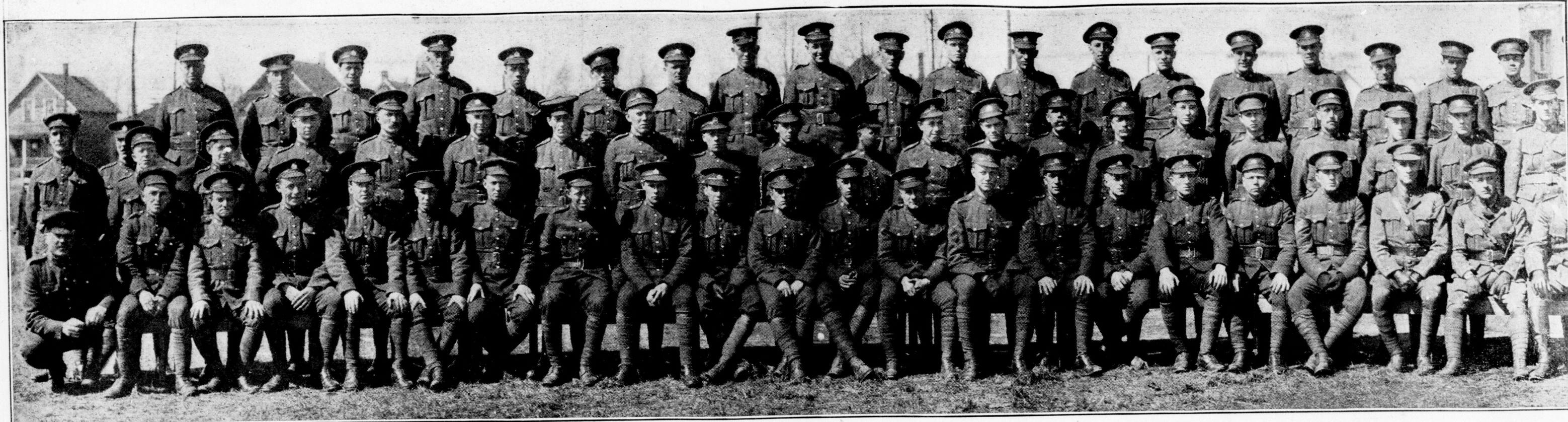

A despatch rider of the Headquarters Staff, 2nd Canadian Division, who has been in action for the past nine months.

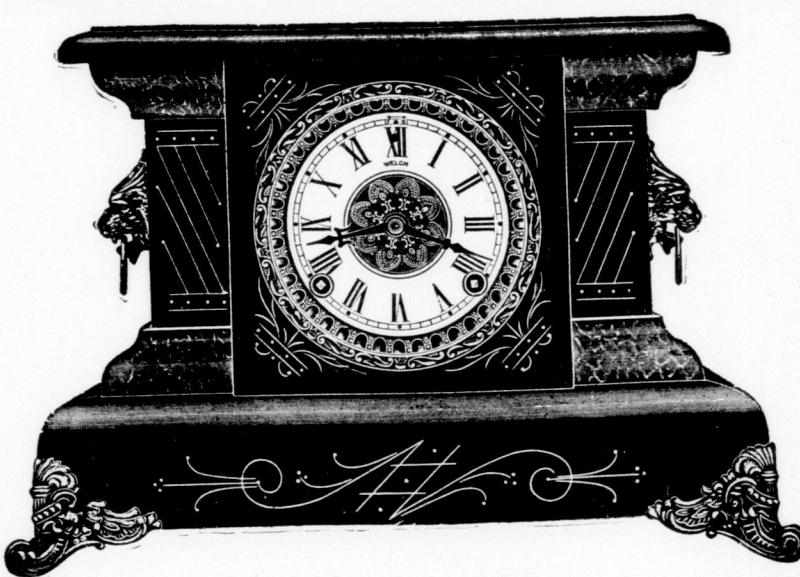
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
