Increase in Immigration in 1888.

During the nine months ended September 30, 1888, 432,802 immigrants arrived in the United States, against 411,282 in the corresponding periol of 1887. Of this number 143,275 came from Great Britain, against 144 131 in the same time in 1887. From Germany 85,098 immigrants arrived, against 88,700 in 1887. From Sweden and Norway 57,801 immig ants arrived, and from Italy 41,293 came, against 58,417 and 38,052 in 1887.
