Chaudiere Bridge and Approaches.

WANTED TENDERS

TENDERS addressed to the Hon. H. G. JOLY, Commissioner of Agriculture and Public Works, and endorsed "Tender for Chaudiere Bridge and Approaches," will be received at 16 ST. JAMES STREET, MONT-REAL, up to NOON of MONDAY, 31st MARCH, for the construction of all the MASONRY required in connection with the Bridge across the Ottawa River, which will consist of Eloven Piers and Four Abutments, together with all the Earth and Rock Excavation and Embankment required to make the connection between the Quebec, Montreal, Ottawa and Occidental Railway, in the City of Hull, in the Province of Quebec, and the Canada Central Railway, in the City of Ottawa, in the Province of Ontario

Contractors will be shown soundings, positions of the Abutments and Piers of the Bridge, and of the line generalty, on application at the Government Engineer's Office, 16 St. James Street, Montreal, at any time after this date, but detailed plans and specifications can only be seen on and after THURSDAY, the 20th MARCH,

No tender will be received upless made upon the printed form attached to the specification, nor unless ac companied with a certified cheque for one thousand dollars, which sum shall be forfeited if the party tendering declines entering into contract for the works at the rate and on the terms stated in his tender.




