- 8. To encourage and facilitate exchanges and visits, not otherwise provided for, of writers, theatre stage directors, architects, specialists in different branches of the law, and other persons engaged in cultural and professional activities, for familiarization with areas of interest and for participation in meetings and symposia. Terms will be worked out in advance by the organizations concerned on a mutually acceptable basis:
- 9. To exchange in 1987-88 for a period up to two weeks, visits of delegations of archivists, one mission from each country, consisting of two experts, to familiarize themselves with the work on specific questions of interest to archivist organizations of both countries, and to exchange information on existing archival systems and research and development under way in a number of areas of archival techniques and processes including automated information retrieval techniques. The sending side will be responsible for international travel and the receiving side will bear the costs of internal travel and will pay a per diem to cover the costs of accommodation The Central Archives Administration under the and meals.
