## ARTICLE III

In accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the contracting Governments will encourage the establishment of direct contacts between competent Canadian and Soviet organizations and industrial enterprises and, as may be appropriate, the conclusion of separate agreements or contracts. Such agreements or contracts shall be concluded in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective states.

## ARTICLE IV

The contracting Governments shall create a Mixed Commission, the composition of which they will determine, which will meet normally once a year, alternately in Ottawa and Moscow. The Mixed Commission will examine, review and confirm programmes for the implementation of this Agreement. It will examine proposals to facilitate cooperation in special fields within the framework of the Agreement. It may propose changes in the Agreement if necessary. The contracting Governments may agree, between the meetings of the Mixed Commission, on additions and modifications to programmes for the implementation of this Agreement.

## ARTICLE V

- (a) This Agreement enters into force from the date of signature.
- (b) This Agreement shall remain in force for a period of five years and thereafter will be extended automatically for further periods of five years unless either Government gives notice of termination not less than six months prior to the expiry of the initial agreement or of any renewal thereof. By agreement between the two Governments the Agreement may be extended for any other period.
