EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note of March 10, 1961, proposing an agreement between the Government of Iran and the Government of Canada for the modification of the visa requirements for non-immigrant entry into our two countries.

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the proposals contained in your Note under reference are acceptable to the Canadian Government and to confirm that your Note and this reply constitute an Agreement between our two Governments which shall come into force thirty days from the date of this Note and which shall remain in force until two months after the date of the receipt of a Note of termination by either Government.

Accept, Excellency, the renewed assurances of my highest consideration.
