I have the honour to refer to your Note No. 48 of April 7, 1972 proposing the extension for a period of one year, from April 24, 1972, of the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America on reciprocal fishing privileges in certain areas off their coasts, signed at Ottawa, April 24, 1970.(1)

In reply I have the honour to inform you that the proposal set forth in your Note is acceptable to the Government of Canada, who agree that your Note and this reply in both the English and French languages shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, which agreement shall enter into force on the date of this reply.
