Community, an effort to make the Atlantic relationship more responsive to current realities, can be beneficial to all concerned.

In this context the suggestion of a Conada/European Community declaration is attractive. But the determining factor will be substance -- not form. Canada is seeking opportunities to develop a dynamic, meaningful and distinctive long-term relationship with the European Community. If it is clear that such a declaration can contribute to this objective we will be ready to participate in its elaboration.

With or without a declaration the future evolution of the Community's trans Atlantic relationship will be of critical interest to Canada. I am confident that common interests and common sense will prevail.
