## COLLOQUIUM ON CANADA/UNITED KINGDOM RELATIONS

The Honourable Allan J. MacEachen, Deputy Prime Minister and Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today that he would attend a Colloquium on Canada/U.K. relations in Halifax May 13 and 14.

Mr. MacEachen will address the Halifax branch of the Canadian Institute of International Affairs on the subject of Canada/U.K. relations at the Lord Nelson Hotel on Sunday, May 13, at 4:00 pm. He will also speak at the opening of the Colloquium at the Saraguay Club on Monday, May 14 at 9:00 am.

The Colloquium, sponsored by the Department of External Affairs and organized by the Centre for Foreign Policy Studies of Dalhousie University, will bring together academics, business people, parliamentarians and officials from Canada and the United Kingdom to examine relations between the two countries in the light of recent international developments.

During his visit to Halifax Mr. MacEachen will also hold talks with Baroness Young, British Minister of State for Foreign and Commonwealth Affairs, on Canada/U.K. relations and international affairs. Baroness Young will also be attending the Colloquium.
