Copy of memorandum sent to Mrs. Fay, Presidents of the T
Alumnae Society of McGill March 26th

It is with great regret that many of the members of
the Alumnae Society have heard of the proposal of the
Principal and Governors of the University to erect a
gymnasium and dormitories on Sherbrooke St in the
hollow in front of the Physics Building.

The present arrangement of the buildings about
the Campus with the open space stretching up from
Sherbrooke St. is very pleasing and it seems a pity with
so much space available about the Stadium to spoil this
effect with a five story building which would completely
hide the picturesque front of the Physics Building.

The latter building is already darkened on the
northern side by the Chemistry and Mining building and
must inevitably have its lighting further affected by
a five story building to the south of it.

With a long sighted view to the future development
of the University the area above Pine Ave seems the
suitable centre for the general life and physical
activities of the Students —
